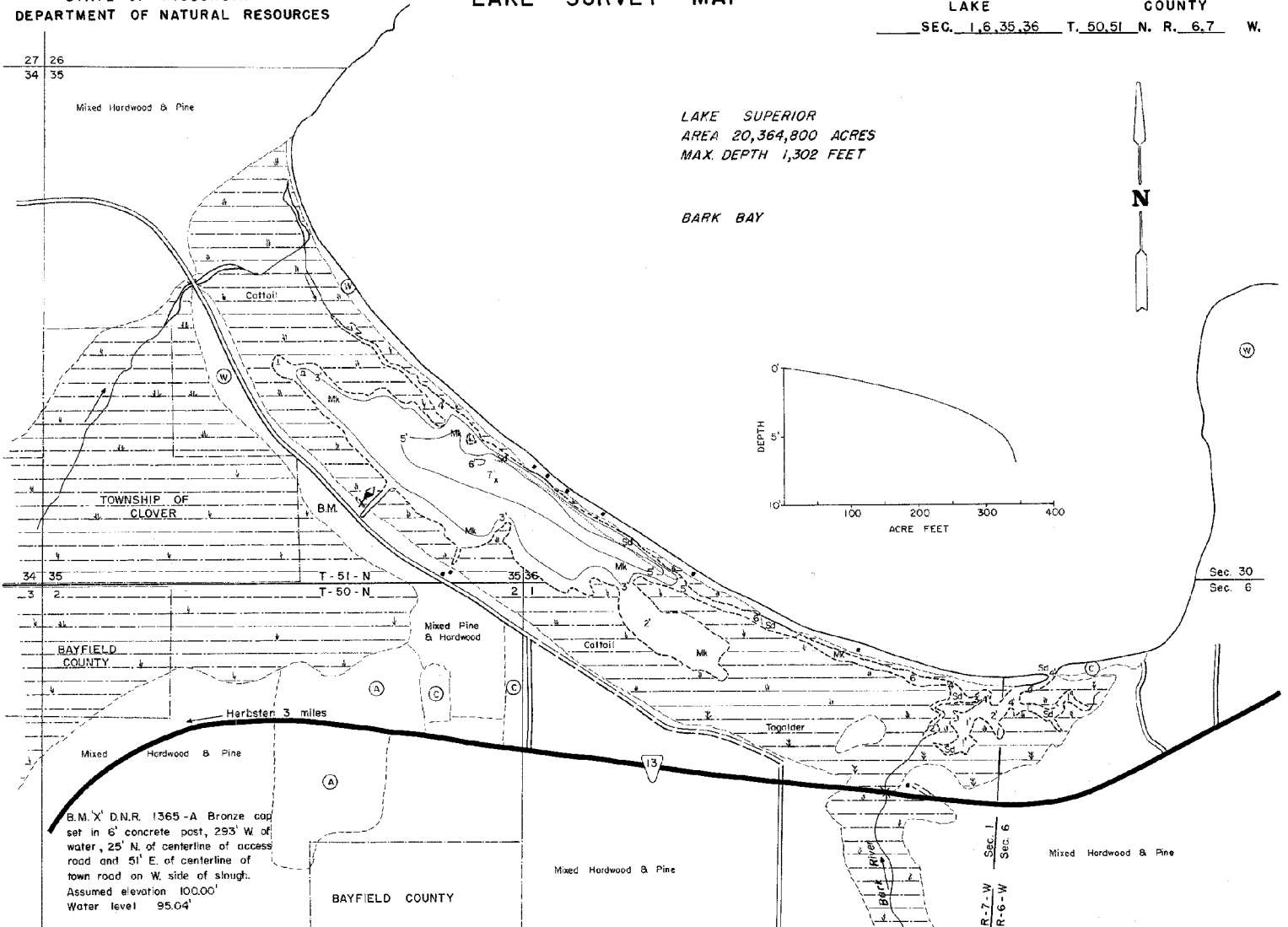

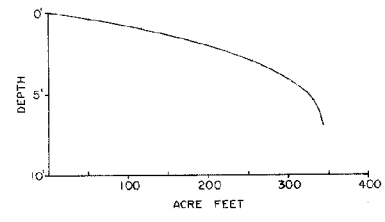
## LAKE SURVEY MAP
