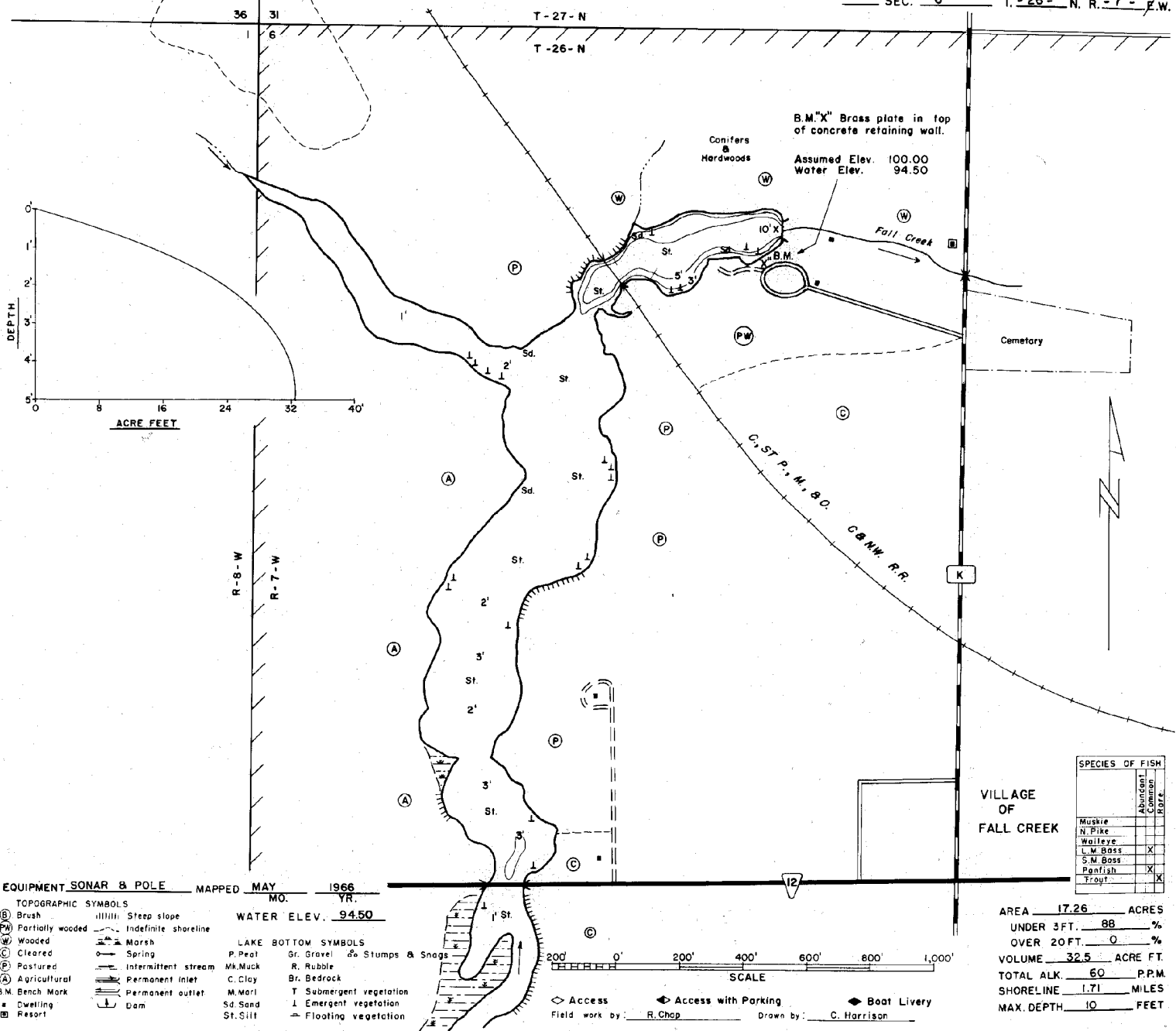
LAKE SURVEY MAP

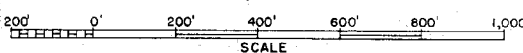
