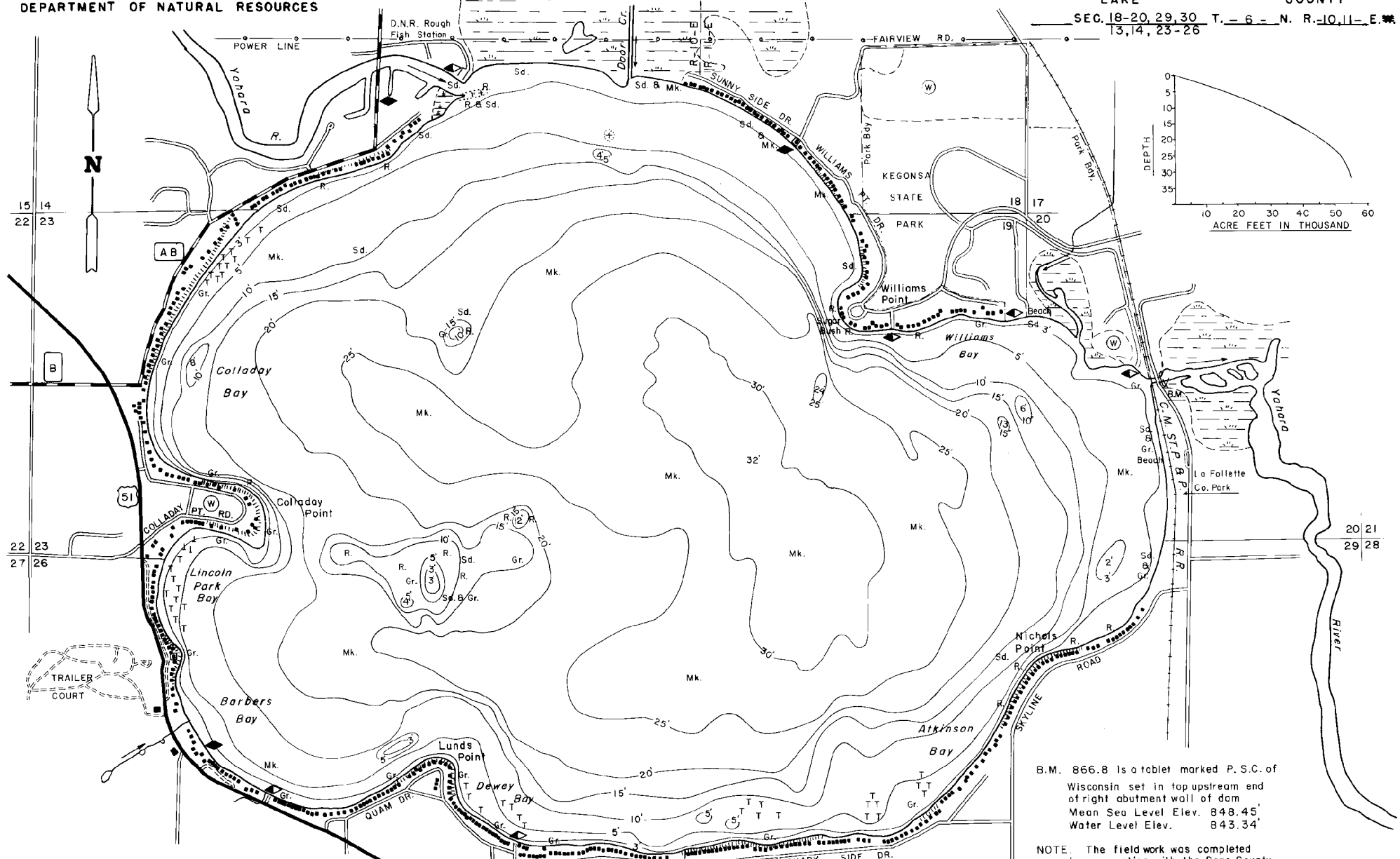

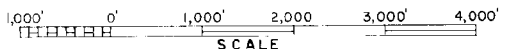


B.M. 866.8 is a tablet marked P.S.C. of Wisconsin set in top upstream end of right abutment wall of dam
