LAKE SURVEY MAP

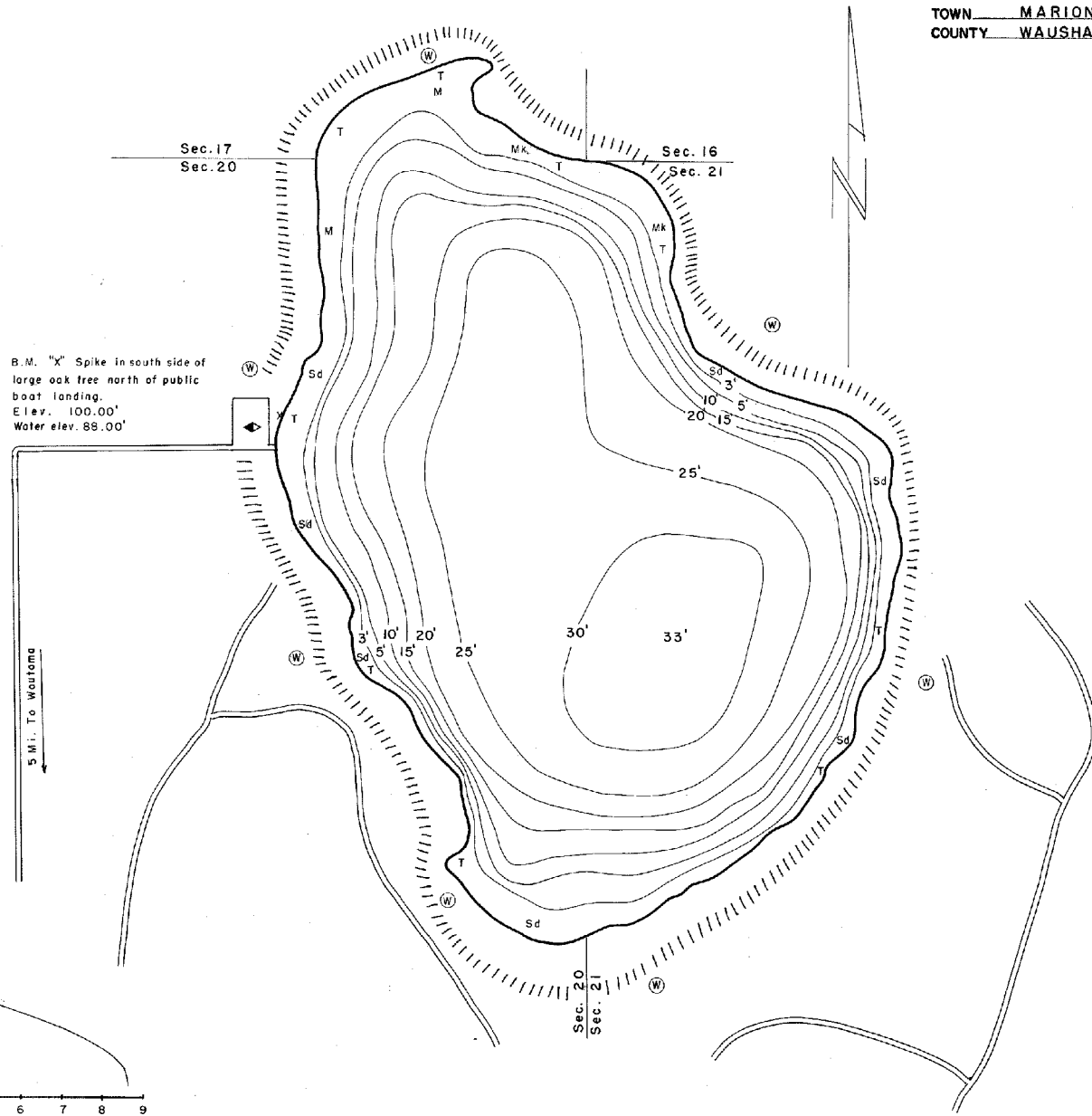

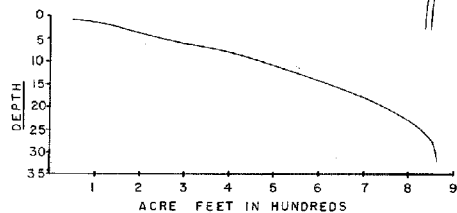
