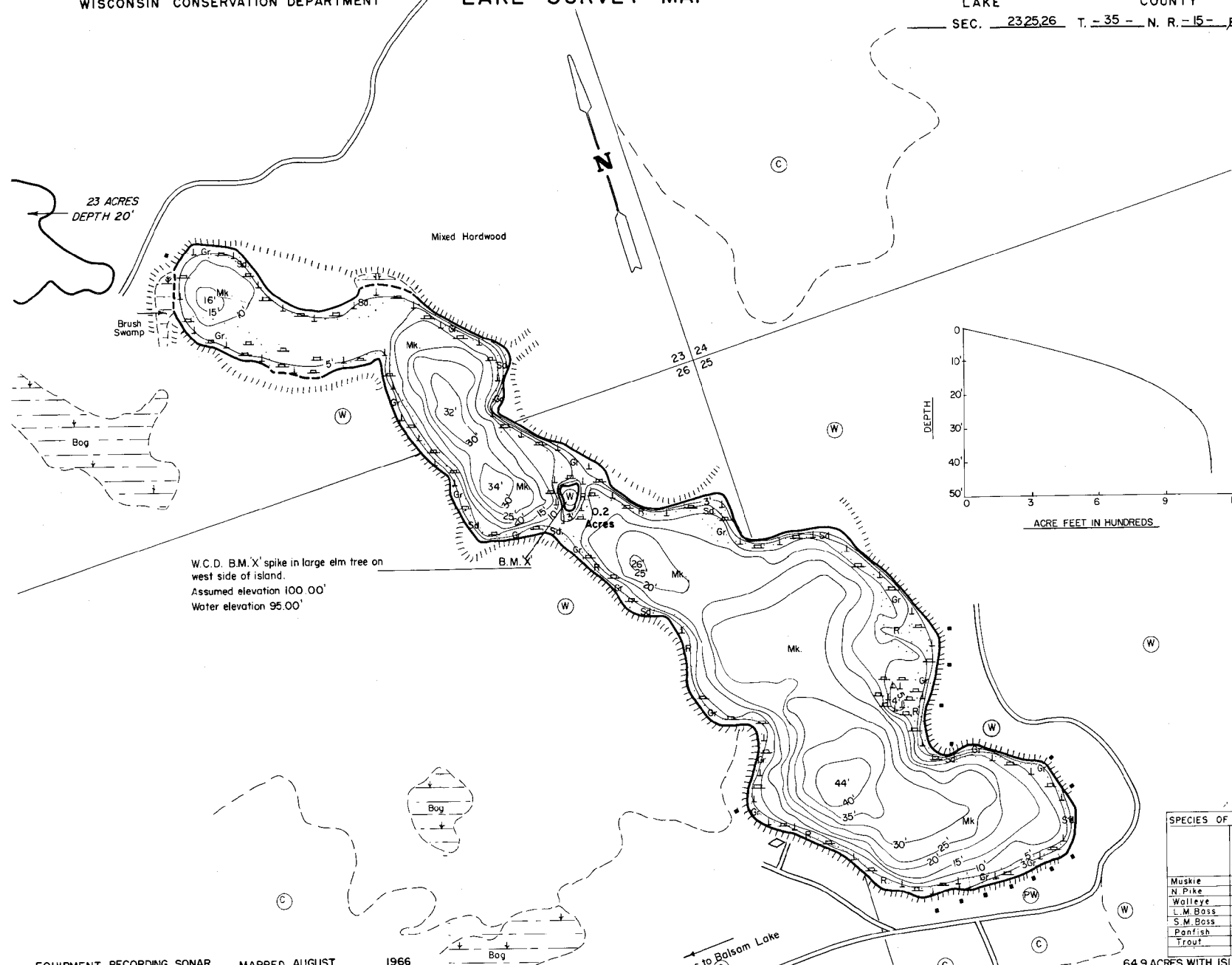


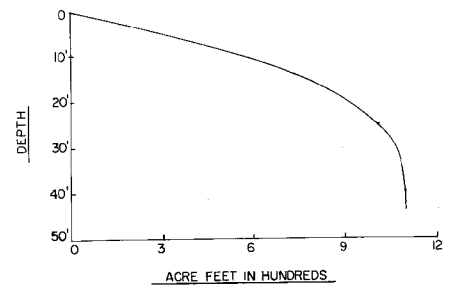

 Water elevation 95.00'

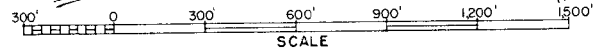


EQUIPMENT RECORDING SONAR MAPPED AUGUST 1966
