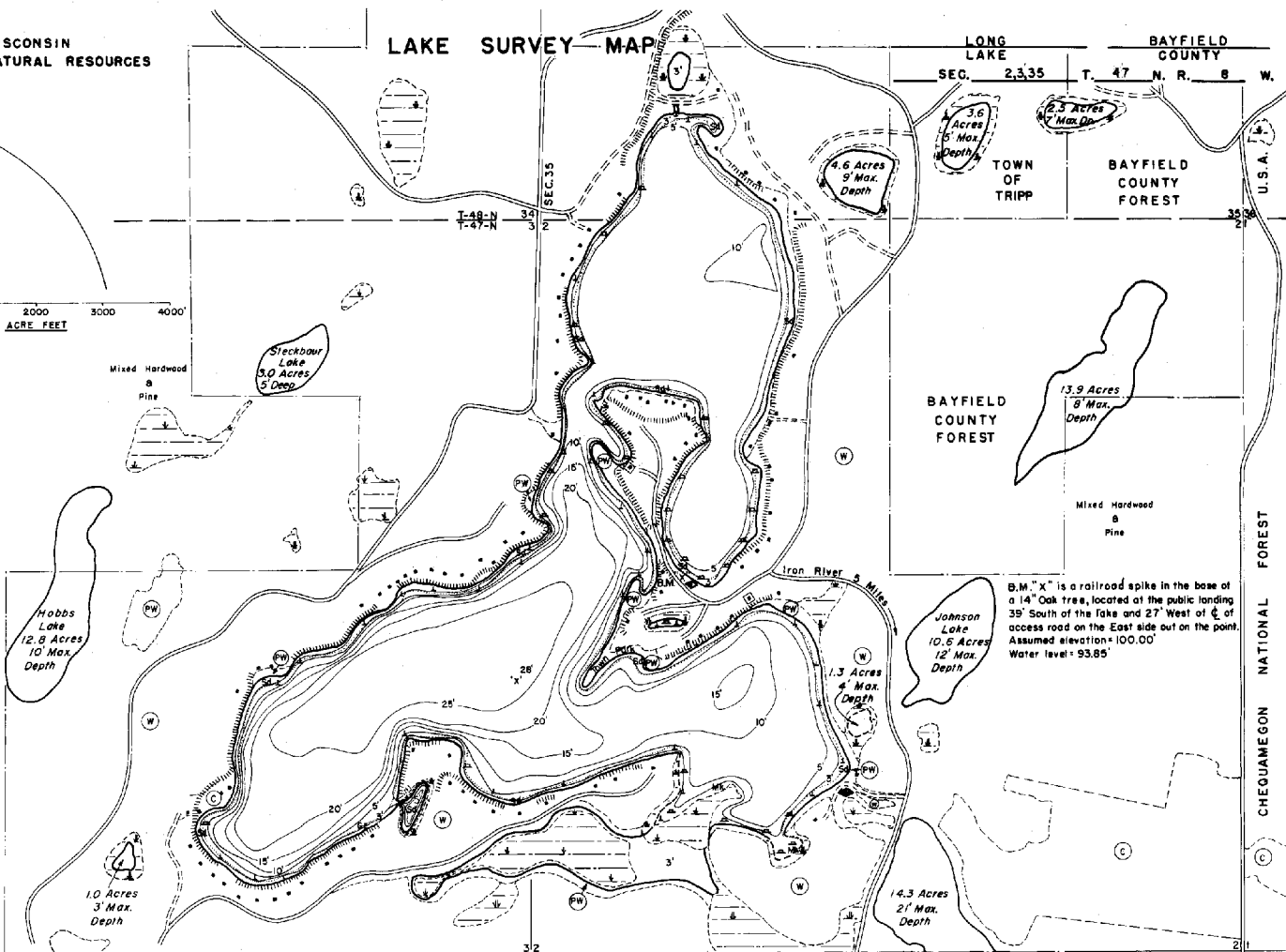
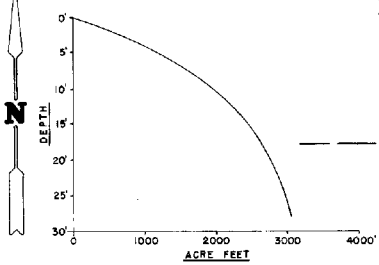

SEC. 2,3,35 T. 47 N. R. 8 W.

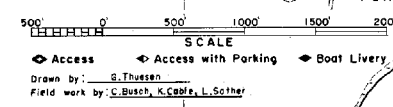
