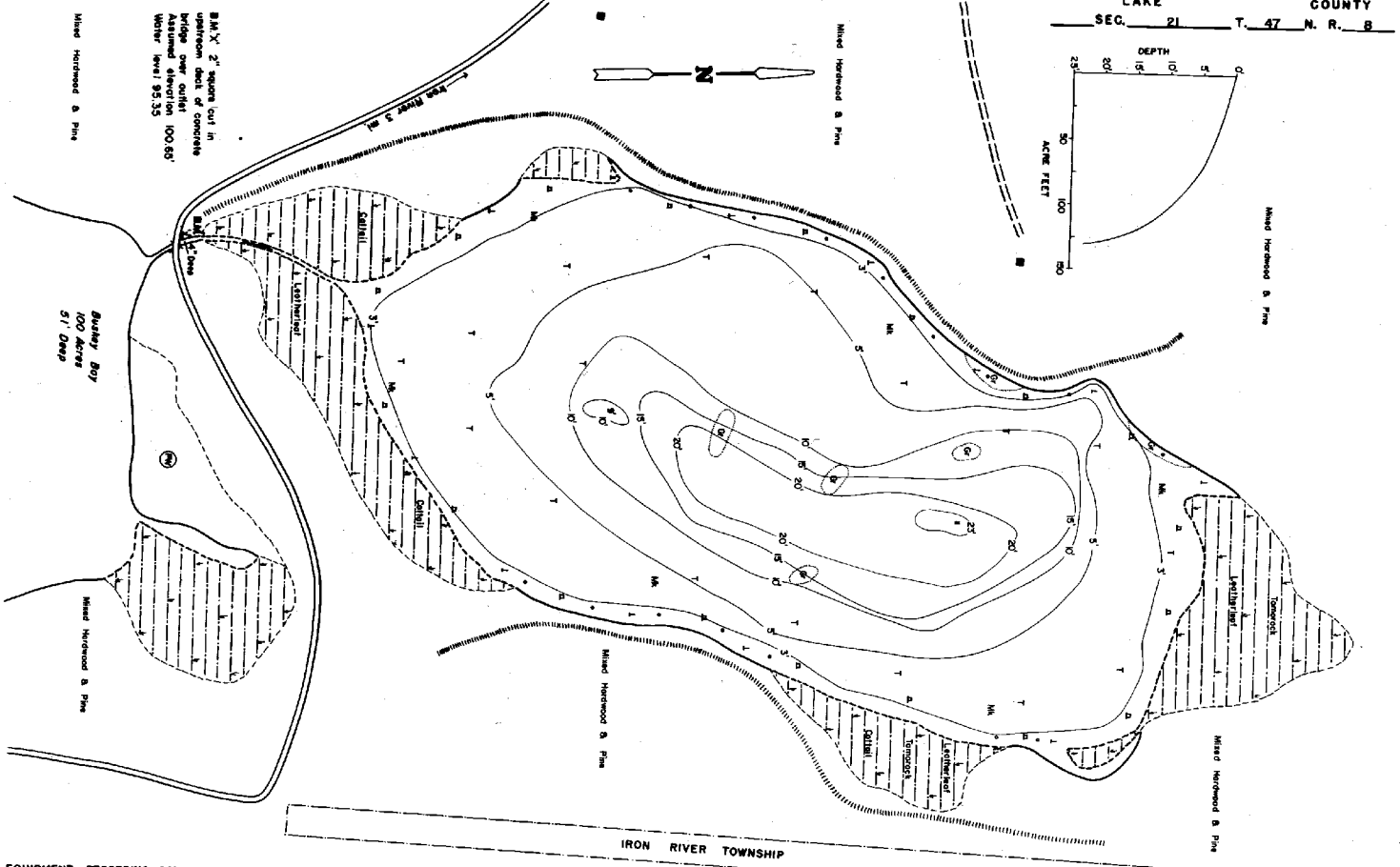


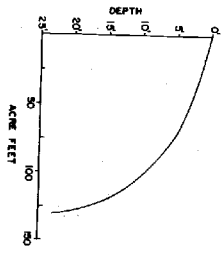

SEC. 21 T. 47 N. R. 8 W.

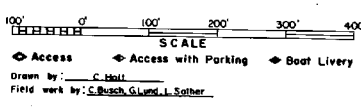


B.M. X 2" square cut in
